

DISCLOSURE REGARDING THE HANDLING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION AND RELATED CONSENT

Provided in accordance with Articles 13 and 23 of the Italian Data Protection Code

In accordance with the Italian Data Protection Code (i.e. Legislative Decree no. 196/2003), Cantore S.r.l. hereby informs you that the handling and disclosure of personal details and other sensitive information provided by you, the Data Subject, are to be processed both manually and electronically for purposes related to our business, i.e. for the provision of commercial brokerage services. Provision of such information is not mandatory. There are, however, cases in which failure to provide all of the information needed in an accurate manner could be an impediment to the full execution of the relationship between Cantore S.r.l. and the Data Subject. Cantore S.r.l. shall be the Data Controller of your personal information and may appoint employees of our organization as Data Processors. One such Data Processor is Rossano Esposito.

The information provided may be handled in accordance with the instructions provided and under the direct supervision of any Data Processors that should be involved in the said handling and who work for and in the interests of Cantore S.r.l. As the Data Subject, you may, at any time, request to receive an up-to-date list of these Data Processors by writing to one of the addresses specified below.

The collection, organization, archiving, processing, updating, comparison, use, suspension, elimination and/or destruction of your personal information shall take place, both manually and electronically, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations concerning confidentiality and data protection.

All of the personal data held by Cantore S.r.l. shall be stored and processed using systems that ensure the utmost security and confidentiality as required under Title V of the Italian Data Protection Code. As the Data Subject, you may exercise all of your rights as defined under Article 7 of said Code, a translation of which is provided below:

- 1. Data subjects have the right to receive confirmation of the existence or absence of personal data that concerns them, even if not yet recorded, and to receive a copy of such data in a clear and intelligible format.*
- 2. Data subjects have the right to receive an indication as to: a) the origin of the personal data; b) the purposes for which it is handled and the related procedures; c) the procedures followed in the event of electronic data processing; d) the name and contact information of the data controller, data processors and the representative appointed in accordance with Article 5(2); e) the parties or categories of parties to which the personal data may be disclosed in their role as data processor or appointed representative within Italy.*
- 3. Data subjects have the right to request: a) updates, corrections, or any desired additions to the information on file; b) that the information be removed or made anonymous, or that data processed illegally be blocked, including information which is not required for the purposes for which it was gathered or subsequently processed; c) verification that such transactions, as specified under points (a) and (b) above, and related content have been brought to the attention of parties to whom the data has been disclosed or disseminated, unless such requirement should prove impossible or should require a disproportionate use of resources as compared with the right to be protected.*
- 4. Furthermore, data subjects have the right to object, in whole or in part: a) and for just cause, to the handling of personal information that concerns them, even if related to the purposes for which the data was collected; b) to the handling of personal data that concerns them for the purposes of sending direct mail or other marketing materials or for market research or other marketing communications.*

Cantore S.r.l. further informs you that, for the purposes connected with the conduction of our business and for the provision of the services you have requested, your personal information may be made available to third parties who will perform the data processing in accordance with the instructions provided and under the direct supervision of Cantore S.r.l. As the Data Subject, you may, at any time, request an up-to-date list of said outsourcers.
